### RULES AND DETAILS:

- Spend the morning strolling with your furry friends while exploring the Kutztown Park and community.
- Meet with vendors, shelters, and rescues, and chat with friends while walking and wagging your way through Kutztown.
- Even if you're dogless, you can still 'hound' your friends and families for donations for this great cause, take part in the dog walk, and/or fall in love with an adoptable pooch from one of the rescues and shelters.
- All pledges and donation money are due the day of the walk. Checks should be made payable to Friend, Inc.
- On the day of the Walk, all participants should report to the registration table at the lower brick pavilion in Kutztown Park beginning at 10:00am.
- All children 12 and under must be accompanied by an adult.
- No more than two dogs per walker.
- Keep your dog on a short non-retractable leash (6' or shorter).
- Dogs must wear current ID tags.
- Vaccinations should be up to date with a rabies tag.
- You are responsible for your dog's behavior.
- No aggressive dogs or dogs in heat please.
- Dogs under 6 months of age may be happier at home.
- And please clean up after your furry friend ... bags available at registration table.
- Have a great time walking your furever friend!
